



# Biophysics Faculty position

The Physics department at University of the Andes, Colombia's top ranked research university, is looking to fill a tenure-track position in the area of Biophysics. The research program of the successful candidate should strengthen existing research areas (Systems Biology, Synthetic Biology, Cell Mechanics and Light Sheet Microscopy), and be viable in the local research environment. Experimental, computation and theory-oriented candidates are all encouraged to apply. The successful applicant will have a strong publication record with an emphasis on quality rather than quantity, and ideally will have postdoctoral experience.

The position requires teaching of one introductory course and one advanced course each semester with only one course the first semester. The candidate can apply for a small startup grant, and is expected to then apply for external funding. Fluency in English or Spanish is required, and after a year the candidate is expected to have learned enough Spanish for teaching. Initial reviews of the applications will be done on August 15 2016, with the possibility of the position remaining open until a suitable candidate is chosen. Ideally the candidate will start the position in January 2017.
