



## **POSTDOCTORAL POSITION IN SOFT MATTER THEORY**

Applications are invited for a postdoctoral research associate to work in the Soft Matter Theory group of the [Laboratoire de Physique des Solides](#) (University Paris-Sud) in Orsay, near Paris on a research project funded by the [French National Agency for Research](#) (ANR) for a period of up to 2 years. The project focuses on the statistical physics of colloidal systems, in particular chiral liquid crystals.

Successful candidates should have a PhD in Condensed Matter Physics, Computational or Physical Chemistry or another relevant subject area. The candidate should have a background in soft/biological matter or statistical physics, as well as experience with numerical methods and computer programming.
